

## Managers, Coaches & Players

#### Rule 1.01:

One Manager

- Not more than two rostered coaches
- If one of the coaches will be late for the game let the umpire know, it is OK for that coach to go in the dugout once he/she arrives
- You may NOT substitute a non-rostered coach for a coach who will be late or absent
- There must always be at least one adult in the dugout at all times if there are players in the dugout
- NON COMPETITIVE MINORS: One manager & three(3) coaches may be used.



### Managers, Coaches & Players

#### 3.09

1.Players, Manager and Coaches may not sit in stands or mingle/chat with spectators during the game. Stay in the dugout!

2.Regular Season only - Managers or coaches are now permitted to warm up a pitcher at home plate or in the bullpen or elsewhere at any time including in-game warm-up, pregame warm-up, and in other instances. They may also stand by to observe a pitcher during warm-up in the bullpen.

#### Additional drills a coach/manager can do:

Coaches & Managers hitting or throwing infield is ok.

Batting practice is ok.

Demo drills are ok.





### Managers, Coaches & Players

#### 3.17

- 1. Only eligible players in uniform may be in the dugout
- 2. Players must stay in the dugout unless they are in the game
- 3. No bat boys/bat girls (sorry, Little Billy's little brother)
- 4. Injured players may be in dugout, must be in uniform
- 5. No electronics used for communication (penalty.....ejection) (apps OK)





# **Rule 4.05**

### Base Coaches

- Eligible players, adult manager or coach (coach under 18 must wear a helmet)
- Both may be adults provided that there is at least one adult in the dugout.
- But Little League encourages you to use the kids as coaches – it's fun for them and a great learning experience





# **Rule 4.07**

- Removal of Ejected Manager, Coach or Player (includes pre & post game)
- When a manager, coach, or player is ejected from a game, they shall leave the field immediately and take no further part in that game. They may not sit in the stands and may not be recalled.
- A manager or coach ejected from a game must not be present at the game site for the remainder of that game.
- If ejected you are ineligible for the next game, including pregame and postgame activities.





# Inability to field a team

### **MUST BE APPROVED BY THE LOCAL BOD**

4.16-Before the game begins

You are allowed to start a game with 8 players, the 9<sup>th</sup> spot in the batting order will be a skip or out.

4.17-After the game begins

You are allowed to continue game with 8 players, the 9<sup>th</sup> spot in the batting order will be a skip or out.

NOTE: If not approved by the BOD, The game will not start or continue.



# **Pool Play**

Pool Play is the responsibility of each league.

- The league's player agent will create and run the pool.
- Managers and/or coaches will not have the right to randomly pick and choose players from the pool.
- Pool players may not pitch.
- NOTE: Players may not be "borrowed" from an opponent. They must be assigned by the player agent.
