To Junior Baseball Northern California Section Champions:

I'd like to congratulate your team on successfully advancing to the final level of tournament play for Junior Baseball in 2021! We in District 35 hope your experience in our district will be enjoyable and successful. I have attached the Tournament Bracket, Announcer's List and Northern California Dress Code.

The Junior Baseball Northern California State tournament will be played at the historic Recreation Park in Healdsburg, CA (hosted by Healdsburg LL). The facility address is **515 Piper St, Healdsburg, CA 95448**. This facility has "covered" grandstands, restrooms, and a full-service snack bar. Please note that no pets are allowed on the premises.

Healdsburg LL shares Rec Park with a Collegiate Summer League team (the Healdsburg Prune Packers). The Prune Packers will have games in the afternoon prior to a few of our evening tournament games. They have graciously offered all players wearing their team jersey will have free admission to any of their games. https://www.prunepackers.org/printable-schedule

There will be an **Opening Ceremony at 5:00pm on Saturday, July 24** between the 2nd and 3rd game. ALL teams are expected to participate in the ceremony. Any (and all) Northern California DA's and Staff are invited to attend also!

As soon as you win your Section tournament, please complete the Announcer's List of Players (attached) and email it to me. Also, a team photo with the Section Championship Banner would be appreciated.

Managers are expected to "check-in" with tournament staff upon arrival at the facility each game. <u>Affidavit</u> <u>Binders (with ALL supporting documentation) will be checked and re-verified prior to your first game and must</u> <u>conform to Little League Headquarters standards</u>. The Affidavit Binders must also include:

- All players must have a signed LL Medical Release and Concussion Awareness form.
- All participants must have a signed LL Form Release and Waiver (formerly Model Release).
- All managers and coaches must have Concussion Awareness, Abuse Awareness and Sudden Cardiac Arrest training certificates.

Bring your Affidavit Binder (with all supporting documents) to each game. You cannot play without it.

As covered by Tournament Rules, home/visitor will be determined by a coin toss <u>at least</u> one (1) hour prior to game time. Home/visitor dugouts are pre-determined by the host field. (Note: you <u>do not</u> have choice of dugout.) Managers and coaches may be asked to show a government approved photo ID to gain access to field. <u>Managers and coaches are expected to adhere to the Northern California Dress Code without exception</u>.

As for recommendations on hotel arrangements, Sonoma County is considered "wine country" so don't be shocked by higher than normal room rates. Healdsburg proper is very "pricey" so I would recommend expanding your horizons as far south as Rohnert Park and as far north as Cloverdale (including Santa Rosa and

Windsor). There are plenty of "mid-priced" options such as Hampton Inns, Holiday Inn Express's, La Quinta's, etc.



NORTHERN CALIFORNIA TOURNAMENT DRESS CODE

Little League Baseball – Docker-type pants, slacks or hemmed shorts are required for managers and coaches; no denim-type pants/shorts or camo pants/shorts will be allowed. Gusseted pockets on cargo-type shorts should lay flat. Shorts, including cargo-type shorts, MUST be no higher than 2 inches above the knees and no lower than the knees. The pants, slacks or shorts must be the same color for the manager and coaches. Collared shirts or team jersey/tee shirts are required and should be tucked in the pants. No tank tops are allowed.

Intermediate/Junior/Senior League – Managers and coaches may wear full uniforms. If not in full uniform, the same dress code for Little League Baseball will apply here.

ALL LEVELS: No open toe shoes or sandals will be allowed.

ALL LEVELS: Team hats are required for the manager and coaches.

Any manager or coach who does not conform to the Dress Code will not be allowed on the playing field before or during the game.

The purpose of the Dress Code is to insure an acceptable uniform appearance of all participants and to promote a positive role model for the players and spectators at the tournament sites. The host District Administrator, or his/her designee (e.g. ADA or Tournament Director) at the tournament site, will use their discretion in determining what is appropriate within the guidelines of the Dress Code and their determination is <u>final</u> for their tournament site.
