NORTHERN CALIFORNIA TOURNAMENT DRESS CODE

Little League Baseball – Docker-type pants, slacks or hemmed shorts are required for managers and coaches; no denim-type pants/shorts or camo pants/shorts will be allowed. Gusseted pockets on cargo-type shorts should lay flat. Shorts, including cargo-type shorts, MUST be no higher than 2 inches above the knees and no lower than the knees. The pants, slacks or shorts must be the same color for the manager and coaches. Collared shirts or team jersey/tee shirts are required and should be tucked in the pants. No tank tops are allowed.

Intermediate/Junior/Senior League – Managers and coaches may wear full uniforms. If not in full uniform, the same dress code for Little League Baseball will apply here.

ALL LEVELS: No open toe shoes or sandals will be allowed.

ALL LEVELS: Team hats are required for the manager and coaches.

Any manager or coach who does not conform to the Dress Code will not be allowed on the playing field before or during the game.

The purpose of the Dress Code is to insure an acceptable uniform appearance of all participants and to promote a positive role model for the players and spectators at the tournament sites. The host District Administrator, or his/her designee (e.g. ADA or Tournament Director) at the tournament site, will use their discretion in determining what is appropriate within the guidelines of the Dress Code and their determination is final for their tournament site.
