## CA DISTRICT 35 LITTLE LEAGUE INTERLEAGUE RULES – SENIOR

## All play will be in accordance with the Official Little League Baseball Rulebook (Senior Division) with the following exceptions:



- 1. D35 Interleague is part of the Regular Season. As such, Regular Season Little League playing and pitching/catching rules will be in full effect. Any violation of the mandatory play rules and/or pitching rules will result in the removal of the team manager for one (1) game. A second violation will result in a three (3) game suspension. A third violation will result in expulsion for the remainder of the season.
- 2. The <u>minimum</u> Roster Size will be ten (10). *Pool Players [Regulation V(c)] are allowed at the discretion of the team's league*. Age/Talent appropriate players will come from that team's league per the Regulation. Players may not be "borrowed" from an opponent. They must be assigned by that league's player agent. Pool Players must start the game and bat in the 9<sup>th</sup> spot. <u>They may not pitch</u>. *[Interleague Playoffs: rosters are "frozen". No players may be added to roster and Pool Players will NOT be allowed.]*
- 3. Rule 3.03-Senior League Designated Hitter Rule is NOT in effect.
- 4. The Interleague uses the standard 9-Player Batting Order. [Rule 4.04 is not in effect.]
- 5. A game may not start (or continue) with less than <u>eight (8) players</u>. (Regular Season: the 9<sup>th</sup> spot will be "skipped" without penalty when there are 8 players.) [Interleague Playoffs: the 9<sup>th</sup> spot will be considered an "out" each turn at-bat.]
- 6. The 10/15-Run Rule will be in effect during ALL games. [Rule 4.10(e)]
- 7. Rule 7.14(a) (Special Pinch Runner) is in effect for ALL games.
- 8. Rule 7.14(b) (Courtesy Runner with 2 outs) is in effect for ALL games for <u>catchers</u> <u>ONLY</u>.
- 9. Rule 6.02(c) "One Foot in the Batter's Box" Rule will be in effect during ALL games.
- 10. Rule 9.01(d) Note: The Stealing and Relaying of Signs to alert the batter of pitch selection and/or location IS <u>Unsportsmanlike Behavior</u> for purposes of this Rule.
- 11. ALL Interleague games will be scheduled (and rescheduled due to rainouts, suspensions, or cancellations) by the D35 Interleague Scheduling Coordinator. NOTE: The refusal to play an Interleague game as scheduled (or rescheduled) will be grounds for removing the team from the balance of the Interleague season. NO TAKING FORFEITS TO AVOID PLAYING A TEAM.
- 12. Home Team manager will notify Away Team manager **at least 2 hours before game time** in the event the field is unplayable so unnecessary travel can be minimized. The game will be referred to the D35 Scheduling Coordinator for rescheduling.

- 13. A team must give a **minimum 24-hour notice** to the D35 Scheduling Coordinator in the event they cannot field a team for a game. <u>If the reason for postponement is deemed appropriate, the game will be rescheduled</u>.
- 14. BOTH Teams are responsible for providing three (3) NEW baseballs (RS or RS-T) each for each game. Those baseballs will not be returned. IF additional baseballs are needed, the Home Team will provide.
- 15. The "Home Team" is responsible for providing two (2) umpires for each game.
- 16. The "Home Team" is responsible for pre-game preparation and lining the field as well as post-game dragging, cleanup and lockup.
- 17. The "Home Team" will provide the official scorekeeper for each game. The "Official Book" must be outside the dugout and accessible to both teams and the umpires. <u>Both teams</u> <u>should agree to the score and pitch counts each half inning</u>.
- 18. **Regular Season games may end in a tie**. [Interleague Playoffs: each game must have a winner.]
- 19. **TIE GAME (with time left on the clock):** 8<sup>th</sup> inning played as normal. Beginning with the 9<sup>th</sup> (and subsequent) innings, the offensive team shall begin its turn at bat with the player who is scheduled to bat last in that respective half inning being placed at second base. [International Tie Breaker]
- 20. The HOME team shall report the Final Score and Pitch Counts [pitcher name, jersey number, league age and actual pitch count (with threshold noted)] for each pitcher used in the game. This report SHALL be completed within 24 hours of the conclusion of the game. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 21. Little League patches are required on all uniforms. [Waived for 2021 Regular Season including Interleague Playoffs.]
- 22. ALL "eligible" teams will participate in the Interleague Playoff Tournament. All players who participate in the Playoffs are required to play a minimum of 6 regular-season games in the Seniors Division. The tournament will be Single-Elimination format. The teams will be "seeded" according to the FINAL Regular Season Interleague standings. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> round games will be hosted by the better seed (and that team will be the designated home team). The Semi-Final and Championship rounds will be played at designated host sites. Home team to be determined by a coin flip for these rounds.
